- 18 (b) This section applies to the construction of a new state building, including a building project otherwise exempt from this 19 20 chapter under Section 2166.003.
- 21 (c) The commission, or the governing body of the appropriate
- 22 agency that is undertaking a building project otherwise exempt from
- this chapter under Section 2166.003, shall use green stormwater 23
- 24 infrastructure in the construction of a state building.
