2 relating to the use, possession, delivery, or manufacture of 3 testing equipment that identifies the presence of fentanyl, 4 alpha-methylfentanyl, or any other derivative or controlled 5 substance analogue of fentanyl.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
SECTION 1. Section 481.125, Health and Safety Code, is
amended by adding Subsection (j) to read as follows:

9 <u>(j) This section does not apply to a person who uses,</u> 10 possesses with the intent to use, delivers, possesses with intent 11 to deliver, or manufactures with intent to deliver testing 12 equipment that identifies the presence of fentanyl, 13 alpha-methylfentanyl, or any other derivative or controlled 14 substance analogue of fentanyl.

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 15 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 16 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 17 governed by the law in effect at the time the offense was committed, 18 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 19 For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 20 21 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 22 before that date.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
