## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to COVID-19 prevention and treatment information provided
3	to individuals receiving a COVID-19 viral test.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 81, Health and Safety Code, is amended by
6	adding Subchapter K to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER K. COVID-19 TESTING, PREVENTION, AND TREATMENT
8	Sec. 81.451. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
9	(1) "COVID-19" means the 2019 novel coronavirus
10	disease.
11	(2) "Health care provider" means a person who is
12	licensed, certified, or otherwise authorized to provide COVID-19
13	viral testing.
14	Sec. 81.452. COVID-19 PREVENTION AND TREATMENT
15	INFORMATION. The department shall post on the department's
16	Internet website a printable brochure containing information or
17	preventative measures and treatments for COVID-19. The brochure
18	must include the following information:

21	(2) the importance of therapeutic prevention of

23	(A) the use of nutraceuticals;
24	(B) the use of prescription medications; and

- 3 (3) the importance of seeking treatment for COVID-19
- 4 as soon as symptoms appear and a list of COVID-19 treatments that
- 5 may be effective, including available medications; and
- 6 (4) advanced home treatments for reducing COVID-19
- 7 symptoms and preventing hospitalization after an individual
- 8 contracts COVID-19, including monoclonal antibody therapy.
- 9 Sec. 81.453. REQUIREMENTS FOR HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS. A
- 10 health care provider who performs a COVID-19 viral test on an
- 11 individual shall, at the time the provider performs the test,
- 12 provide a printed or electronic copy of the brochure described by
- 13 Section 81.452 to the individual.
- 14 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 15 of this Act, the Department of State Health Services shall develop
- 16 and post on the department's Internet website the brochure required
- 17 by Section 81.452, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
