(X) a package of waterproof matches; or(Y) a water purifier.

3 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act do not affect 4 taxes imposed before the effective date of this Act, and the law in 5 effect before the effective date of this Act is continued in effect 6 for purposes of the liability for and collection of those taxes.

7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
