4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 40.021, Human Resources Code, is amended
6	by adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
7	(g) A council meeting held by use of a telephone conference
8	call, video conference call, or other similar telecommunication
9	device:
10	(1) is subject to the notice requirements applicable
11	to other meetings;
12	(2) must be open to the public and audible to the
13	public at the location specified in the notice of the meeting;
14	(3) must provide two-way audio communication:
15	(A) between all board members attending the
16	meeting during the entire meeting; and
17	(B) if public testimony is provided at the
18	meeting, between all board members and a member of the public
19	testifying at the specified meeting location during the public
20	testimony portion of the meeting; and
21	(4) if the two-way audio communication link described
22	by Subdivision (3) is disrupted at any time, may not continue until
23	the two-way audio communication link is reestablished.
24	SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to

- 1 a Family and Protective Services Council meeting held on or after
- 2 the effective date of this Act. A meeting held before the effective
- 3 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date of the
- 4 meeting, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
