## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the use of hypnotically induced statements in a
- 3 criminal trial.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 38, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Article 38.24 to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 38.24. STATEMENTS OBTAINED BY INVESTIGATIVE HYPNOSIS.
- 8 (a) In this article, "investigative hypnosis" means a law
- 9 enforcement technique that uses hypnosis to explore the memory of a
- 10 witness to enhance the witness's recall of a legally relevant
- 11 event, including descriptions of people, conversations, and the
- 12 environment.
- 13 (b) This article applies to all statements made during or
- 14 after a hypnotic session by a person who has undergone
- 15 investigative hypnosis performed by a law enforcement agency for
- 16 the purpose of enhancing the person's recollection of an event at
- 17 <u>issue in a criminal investigation or case, including c</u>ourtroom
- 18 testimony regarding those statements and including statements
- 19 identifying an accused that are made pursuant to pretrial
- 20 <u>identification procedures.</u>
- 21 <u>(c) A statement described by Subsection (b) is not</u>
- 22 admissible against a defendant in a criminal trial, whether offered
- 23 in the guilt or innocence phase or the punishment phase of the
- 24 trial, if the hypnotic session giving rise to the statement was

- 1 performed by a law enforcement agency to investigate the offense
- 2 that is the subject of the trial. Notwithstanding Article 38.23,
- 3 this article does not affect the admissibility of any physical
- 4 evidence, or the testimony of any witness identified, that
- 5 independently corroborates the commission of the offense.
- 6 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to the
- 7 admissibility of a statement in a criminal proceeding that
- 8 commences on or after the effective date of this Act. The
- 9 admissibility of a statement in a criminal proceeding that
- 10 commences before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- 11 law in effect on the date the proceeding commenced, and the former
- 12 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
