- 13 real property.
- 14 (f) A person is not considered to be displaced in connection
- 15 with an acquisition of real property for purposes of Subsection (b)

- 17 (1) the person moves or discontinues the person's
- 18 business, moves personal property, or moves from the person's
- 19 <u>dwelling as a direct result of code enforcement; and</u>
- 20 (2) the code enforcement is due to the person's
- 21 negligence or abandonment of the person's real property.

- 23 this Act, applies only to the acquisition of real property

- 1 or after the effective date of this Act. Acquisition of real
- 2 property initiated before the effective date of this Act is
- 3 governed by the law as it existed immediately before that date, and
- 4 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
