- 2 relating to the Texas Armed Services Scholarship Program.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 61.9773(a), Education Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (a) To receive a scholarship under this subchapter, a
- 7 student must enter into an agreement with the board as provided by
- 8 this section. The agreement must require the student to:
- 9 (1) complete:
- 10 (A) one year [four years] of ROTC training for
- 11 each year that the student receives the scholarship; or
- 12 (B) [complete] another undergraduate officer
- 13 commissioning program such as the United States Marine Corps
- 14 Platoon Leaders Class;
- 15 (2) graduate not later than six years after the date
- 16 the student first enrolls in a public or private institution of
- 17 higher education in this state;
- 18 (3) after graduation, enter into:
- 19 (A) a four-year commitment to be a member of the
- 20 Texas Army National Guard, Texas Air National Guard, Texas State
- 21 Guard, United States Coast Guard, or United States Merchant Marine;
- 22 or
- 23 (B) a contract to serve as a commissioned officer
- 24 in any branch of the armed services of the United States;

- 1 (4) meet the physical examination requirements and all
- 2 other prescreening requirements of the Texas Army National Guard,
- 3 Texas Air National Guard, Texas State Guard, United States Coast
- 4 Guard, or United States Merchant Marine or the branch of the armed
- 5 services with which the student enters into a contract; and
- 6 (5) agree to repay the scholarship if the student:
- 7 (A) fails to maintain satisfactory academic
- 8 progress;
- 9 (B) withdraws from the scholarship program; or
- 10 (C) fails to fulfill a commitment or contract
- 11 described by Subdivision (3).
- 12 SECTION 2. Subchapter FF, Chapter 61, Education Code, is
- 13 amended by adding Section 61.97731 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 61.97731. NOTICE REGARDING MINIMUM AND REQUIRED ROTC
- 15 TRAINING. The board shall post on the board's Internet website and
- 16 provide to each student before the student enters into an agreement
- 17 with the board under Section 61.9773 information regarding the
- 18 number of years of ROTC training that each entity described by
- 19 Section 61.9773(a)(3) requires or recommends before entering into a
- 20 commitment or contract described by that subdivision.
- SECTION 3. Section 61.9773(a), Education Code, as amended
- 22 by this Act, applies beginning with a Texas Armed Services
- 23 Scholarship awarded for the 2024-2025 academic year. A Texas Armed
- 24 Services Scholarship awarded for an academic year before that
- 25 academic year is governed by the law in effect when the scholarship
- 26 was awarded, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 27 purpose.
