A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the composition of districts for the election of

3 members of the Texas Senate.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to ensure the legislature has fulfilled its duty to apportion the state into senatorial districts at its first regular session after the publication of the Twenty-fourth Decennial Census of the United

9 States, as provided by Section 28, Article III, Texas Constitution.

10 SECTION 2. The districts used to elect members of the Texas

11 Senate in 2022, established by Chapter 5 (S.B. 4), Acts of the 87th

12 Legislature, 3rd Called Session, 2021 (PLANS2168 in the Texas

13 Legislature's redistricting system), are hereby ratified and

14 adopted as the permanent districts used to elect members of the

15 Texas Senate.

districts SECTION 3. The legislature finds that the 16 described by SECTION 2 of this Act are a continuation of the 17 districts used for the election of the members of the Senate of the 18 88th Legislature. Accordingly, the legislature finds that 19 enactment of this Act does not require a new senate be chosen for 20 the 89th Legislature for purposes of Section 3, Article III, Texas 21 22 Constitution. The legislature's findings expressed in this section 23 are consistent with the opinion of the court of appeals in 24 Armbrister v. Morales, 943 S.W.2d 202 (Tex. App.-Austin 1997, no

- 2 SECTION 4. The districts described by SECTION 2 of this Act
- 3 apply to the election of the members of the Texas Senate beginning
- 4 with the primary and general elections in 2024 for members of the
- 5 89th Legislature. This Act does not affect the membership or
- 6 districts of the Senate of the 88th Texas Legislature.
- 7 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
