## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the Texas Connectivity Fund and to the allocation and
- 3 the use of certain proceeds from the imposition of state sales and
- 4 use taxes on telecommunications services.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 4, Government Code, is amended
- 7 by adding Chapter 490J to read as follows:
- 8 CHAPTER 490J. TEXAS CONNECTIVITY FUND
- 9 Sec. 490J.0101. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
- 10 "Broadband development account" means the account
- 11 established by Section 490I.0108.
- 12 (2) "Commission" means the Public Utility Commission
- of Texas.
- 14 (3) "Comptroller" means the comptroller of public
- 15 accounts of the State of Texas.
- 16 (4) "Texas Connectivity Fund" or "fund" means the fund
- 17 established by Section 68, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 18 (5) "Universal service fund" means the fund
- 19 <u>established by Chapter 56, Utilities Code.</u>
- 20 <u>Sec. 490J.0102.</u> <u>DEDICATION OF REVENUE TO FUND.</u> The revenue
- 21 of the state that is dedicated or appropriated to the fund pursuant
- 22 to Section 7-e, Article VIII, Texas Constitution, shall be
- 23 deposited to the fund in accordance with Section 7-e, Article VIII,
- 24 Texas Constitution.

- 1 Sec. 490J.0103. ALLOCATION OF FUND REVENUE. (a) At the end
- 2 of each fiscal year, the commission shall prepare a report
- 3 detailing the amount of funds necessary to fulfill the requirements
- 4 of the universal service fund. Upon receipt of that report, the
- 5 comptroller shall transfer from the Texas Connectivity Fund to the
- 6 commission the amount designated in the report.
- 7 (b) The remaining funds deposited in the fund for that
- 8 fiscal year shall be credited to the broadband development account.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 490I.0108(b), Government Code, is
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 (b) The account consists of:
- 12 (1) appropriations of money to the account by the
- 13 legislature, including funds appropriated from the Texas
- 14 Connectivity Fund;
- 15 (2) gifts, donations, and grants, including federal
- 16 grants; and
- 17 (3) interest earned on the investment of the money in
- 18 the account.
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 56.022, Utilities Code, is amended to
- 20 read as follows:
- Sec. 56.022. REVENUE FROM TEXAS CONNECTIVITY FUND. [UNIFORM
- 22 CHARCE. (a) The universal service fund is funded by <u>allocations</u>
- 23 made by the comptroller from the Texas Connectivity Fund  $[\frac{a}{a}]$
- 24 statewide uniform charge payable by each telecommunications
- 25 provider that has access to the customer base].
- 26 [(b) A telecommunications provider shall pay the charge in
- 27 accordance with procedures approved by the commission.

- [(c) The uniform charge is on services and at rates the commission determines. In establishing the charge and the services to which the charge will apply, the commission may not:
- 4 [(1) grant an unreasonable preference or advantage to a
  5 telecommunications provider;
- 6 [(2) assess the charge on pay telephone service; or
- 7 [(3) subject a telecommunications provider to
- 8 unreasonable prejudice or disadvantage.
- 9 SECTION 4. Section 56.023(a), Utilities Code, is amended to 10 read as follows:
- 11 (a) The commission shall:
- 12 (1) in a manner that assures reasonable rates for
- 13 basic local telecommunications service, adopt eligibility criteria
- 14 and review procedures, including a method for administrative
- 15 review, the commission finds necessary to [fund the universal
- 16 service fund and make distributions from the universal service
- 17 fund [that fund];
- 18 (2) determine which telecommunications providers meet
- 19 the eligibility criteria;
- 20 (3) determine the amount of and approve a procedure
- 21 for reimbursement to telecommunications providers of revenue lost
- 22 in providing tel-assistance service under Subchapter C;
- 23 (4) establish and collect fees from the universal
- 24 service fund necessary to recover the costs the department and the
- 25 commission incur in administering this chapter and Chapter 57;
- 26 (5) approve procedures for the [collection and]
- 27 disbursal of the revenue of the universal service fund; and

- 1 (6) audit voucher payments and other expenditures made
- 2 under the specialized telecommunications assistance program
- 3 established under Subchapter E.
- 4 SECTION 5. Section 151.801, Tax Code, is amended by adding
- 5 Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 6 (g) The comptroller shall deposit each fiscal year 50
- 7 percent of the proceeds from the collection of the taxes imposed by
- 8 this chapter on telecommunications services to the credit of the
- 9 Texas Connectivity Fund.
- 10 SECTION 6. The Public Utility Commission of Texas shall
- 11 adopt rules consistent with this Act as soon as practicable after
- 12 the effective date of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 7. (a) This Act takes effect only if the
- 14 constitutional amendment proposed by the 88th Legislature, Regular
- 15 Session, 2023, requiring the automatic appropriation to the Texas
- 16 Connectivity Fund of part of the proceeds from existing state sales
- 17 and use taxes on telecommunications services is approved by the
- 18 voters. If that amendment is not approved by the voters, this Act
- 19 has no effect.
- 20 (b) If this Act takes effect as provided by Subsection (a)
- 21 of this section, this Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
