A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the authority of certain military service members to
- 3 engage in a business or occupation in this state.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 55.004(d), Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (d) A state agency that issues a license that has a
- 8 residency requirement for license eligibility shall adopt rules
- 9 regarding documentation necessary for an applicant who is a
- 10 military service member or military spouse [applicant] to establish
- 11 residency for purposes of this subsection, including by providing
- 12 to the agency a copy of the permanent change of station order for
- 13 the applicant or the applicant's spouse [military service member to
- 14 whom the spouse is married].
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 55.0041, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 16 read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 55.0041. RECOGNITION OF OUT-OF-STATE LICENSE OF
- 18 <u>MILITARY SERVICE MEMBERS AND</u> MILITARY <u>SPOUSES</u> [SPOUSES]. (a)
- 19 Notwithstanding any other law, a military service member or
- 20 military spouse may engage in a business or occupation for which a
- 21 license is required without obtaining the applicable license if the
- 22 member or spouse is currently licensed in good standing by another
- 23 jurisdiction that has licensing requirements that are
- 24 substantially equivalent to the requirements for the license in

- 1 this state.
- 2 (b) Before engaging in the practice of the business or
- 3 occupation, the <u>military service member or</u> military spouse must:
- 4 (1) notify the applicable state agency of the member's
- 5 or spouse's intent to practice in this state;
- 6 (2) submit to the agency proof of the member's or
- 7 spouse's residency in this state in accordance with rules adopted
- 8 under Section 55.004(d) and a copy of the <u>member's or</u> spouse's
- 9 military identification card; and
- 10 (3) receive from the agency confirmation that:
- 11 (A) the agency has verified the <u>member's or</u>
- 12 spouse's license in the other jurisdiction; and
- 13 (B) the member or spouse is authorized to engage
- 14 in the business or occupation in accordance with this section.
- 15 (c) The <u>military service member or</u> military spouse shall
- 16 comply with all other laws and regulations applicable to the
- 17 business or occupation in this state.
- 18 (d) A military service member or military spouse may engage
- 19 in the business or occupation under the authority of this section
- 20 only for the period during which the military service member or,
- 21 with respect to a military spouse, the military service member to
- 22 whom the [military] spouse is married is stationed at a military
- 23 installation in this state but not to exceed three years from the
- 24 date the member or spouse receives the confirmation described by
- 25 Subsection (b)(3).
- 26 (e) A state agency that issues a license shall adopt rules
- 27 to implement this section. The rules must establish a process for

- 1 the agency to:
- 2 (1) identify, with respect to each type of license
- 3 issued by the agency, the jurisdictions that have licensing
- 4 requirements that are substantially equivalent to the requirements
- 5 for the license in this state; and
- 6 (2) verify that a <u>military service member or</u> military
- 7 spouse is licensed in good standing in a jurisdiction described by
- 8 Subdivision (1).
- 9 (f) In addition to the rules adopted under Subsection (e), a
- 10 state agency that issues a license may adopt rules to provide for
- 11 the issuance of a license to a <u>military service member or</u> military
- 12 spouse to whom the agency provides confirmation under Subsection
- 13 (b)(3). A license issued under this subsection must expire not
- 14 later than the third anniversary of the date the agency provided the
- 15 confirmation and may not be renewed. A state agency may not charge
- 16 a fee for the issuance of the license.
- SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2023, a state agency
- 18 to which Section 55.0041, Occupations Code, as amended by this Act,
- 19 applies shall adopt rules to implement that section.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
