SECTION 6. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to a driver's license issued or renewed on or after June 1, 2024. A driver's license issued or renewed before June 1, 2024, is governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
