1 have an abortion.

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to 2 an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An 3 4 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the 5 6 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of 7 8 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023. 9
