5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 15.001, Water Code, is amended by adding
7	Subdivision (14) to read as follows:
8	(14) "Rural political subdivision" means:
9	(A) a nonprofit water supply or sewer service
10	corporation created and operating under Chapter 67 of this code or a
11	district or authority created under Section 52, Article III, or
12	Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, no part of the service
13	area of which is located in an urban area with a population of more
14	<u>than 50,000;</u>
15	(B) a municipality:
16	(i) with a population of 10,000 or less part
17	of the service area of which is located in an urban area with a
18	population of 50,000 or more; or
19	(ii) located wholly in a county in which no
20	urban area has a population of more than 50,000;
21	(C) a county in which no urban area has a
22	population of more than 50,000; or
23	(D) an entity that:
24	(i) is a nonprofit water supply or sewer

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service corporation created and operating under Chapter 67 of this 1 2 code, a district or authority created under Section 52, Article 3 III, or Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, a 4 municipality, county, or other political subdivision of the state, or an interstate compact commission to which the state is a party; 5 6 and 7 (ii) demonstrates in a manner satisfactory to the board that the entity is rural or the area to be served by the 8 9 project is a wholly rural area despite not otherwise qualifying under Paragraph (A), (B), or (C). 10 SECTION 2. Section 15.434(b), Water Code, is amended to 11 read as follows: 12 13 (b) Of the money disbursed from the fund during the five-year period between the adoption of a state water plan and the 14 adoption of a new plan, the board shall undertake to apply not less 15 16 than: 17 (1) 10 percent to support projects described by Section 15.435 that are for: 18 rural political subdivisions [as defined by 19 (A) 20 Section 15.992]; or agricultural water conservation; and 21 (B) 22 (2) 20 percent to support projects described by Section 15.435, including agricultural irrigation projects, that 23 are designed for water conservation or reuse. 24 25 SECTION 3. Section 17.001, Water Code, is amended by adding Subdivision (26) to read as follows: 26 27 (26) "Rural political subdivision" has the meaning

2	SECTION 4. Section 17.9615(a), Water Code, is amended to
3	read as follows:
4	(a) The board may direct the comptroller to transfer amounts
5	from the financial assistance account to the rural water assistance
6	fund to provide financial assistance <u>to rural political</u>
7	subdivisions under this subchapter for the purposes provided in
8	Section 15.994.
9	SECTION 5. Section 15.992(4), Water Code, is repealed.
10	SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
