- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 5, Water Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 5.1774 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 5.1774. FEES FOR MULTIPLE COMPLAINTS. (a) The
- 8 commission shall charge a person who files a complaint a fee before
- 9 the commission investigates the complaint if, in the same calendar
- 10 year in which the complaint is filed, the person has filed at least
- 11 three complaints with the commission for which neither the
- 12 <u>commission nor a local enforcement official took enforcement action</u>
- 13 before closing the file on the complaint.
- 14 (b) The commission by rule shall establish for each type of
- 15 complaint a fee amount to be charged under Subsection (a) that the
- 16 commission estimates is less than or equal to the cost to the
- 17 commission of investigating most complaints of that type.
- 18 <u>(c)</u> The commission may waive the fee required by Subsection
- 19 (a) for good cause.
- 20 SECTION 2. (a) The Texas Commission on Environmental
- 21 Quality shall adopt the rules required by Section 5.1774, Water
- 22 Code, as added by this Act, as soon as practicable after the
- 23 effective date of this Act.
- 24 (b) Section 5.1774, Water Code, as added by this Act,

- 1 applies only to a complaint filed on or after the effective date of
- 2 the rules adopted under that section. The Texas Commission on
- 3 Environmental Quality may not consider a complaint filed before the
- 4 effective date of the rules for the purposes of determining whether
- 5 to charge a fee under Section 5.1774(a), Water Code, as added by
- 6 this Act.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
