1-21 relating to the operation of statewide technology centers.  
 1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 2054.378, Government Code, is amended by  
 1-24 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as  
 1-25 follows:  
 1-26 (a) The department may operate statewide technology centers  
 1-27 to provide [~~two or more~~] governmental entities, on a cost-sharing  
 1-28 basis, services relating to:  
 1-29 (1) information resources and information resources  
 1-30 technology; and  
 1-31 (2) the deployment, development, and maintenance of  
 1-32 software applications.  
 1-33 (c) The department by rule shall specify the services a  
 1-34 statewide technology center may provide.  
 1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
