Section 2002.056(b-1), Occupations Code, 5 is 6 amended to read as follows: 7 (b-1) The value of a residential dwelling offered or awarded as a prize at a raffle that is purchased by the organization or for 8 which the organization provides any consideration may not exceed 9 \$750,000 [\$250,000]. 10 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 11 to a charitable raffle conducted under Chapter 2002, Occupations 12 13 Code, for which a residential dwelling is offered or awarded as a prize on or after the effective date of this Act. A charitable 14 15 raffle conducted under Chapter 2002, Occupations Code, for which a residential dwelling is offered or awarded as a prize before the 16 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the 17 date the prize was offered or awarded, and the former law is 18 continued in effect for that purpose. 19
