15	passport number, emergency contact information, or payment
16	<u>information</u> of <u>an individual</u> [ <del>a person</del> ] licensed to practice law in
17	this state [that is maintained under Chapter 81 is confidential and
18	may not be disclosed to the public under this chapter if the person
19	to whom the information relates:
20	[ <del>(1) chooses to restrict public access to the</del>
21	information; and
22	[ <del>(2) notifies the State Bar of Texas of the person's</del>
23	choice, in writing or electronically, on a form provided by the
24	state bar].

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1	(d) Subsection (a) does not make confidential or except from
2	required public disclosure the name, state bar identification
3	number, membership class, or eligibility to practice law of an
4	applicant for a license, a license holder, or an individual who
5	previously held a license.
6	(e) To the extent of any conflict, this section prevails
7	over another law that authorizes or requires the release of
8	information maintained by the State Bar of Texas.
9	SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
10	amended by adding Section 552.11765 to read as follows:
11	Sec. 552.11765. CONFIDENTIALITY OF CERTAIN INFORMATION
12	MAINTAINED BY STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY. (a) In this section,
13	"license" means a license, certificate, registration, permit, or
14	other authorization that:
15	(1) is issued by a governmental body described by
16	Section 552.003(1)(A)(i); and
17	(2) an individual must obtain to practice or engage in
18	a particular business, occupation, or profession.
19	(b) Except as provided by Subsections (c) and (d),
20	information maintained by a governmental body described by Section
21	552.003(1)(A)(i) is confidential and excepted from the
22	requirements of Section 552.021 if the information:
23	(1) is a license application; or
24	(2) relates to the home address, home telephone
25	number, electronic mail address, social security number, date of
26	birth, driver's license number, state identification number,
27	passport number, emergency contact information, or payment

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1 information of: 2 (A) an applicant for a license issued by the 3 governmental body; 4 (B) an individual who holds a license issued by 5 the governmental body; or 6 (C) an individual who previously held a license 7 issued by the governmental body. 8 (c) Subsection (b) does not make confidential or except from 9 required public disclosure the name, license number, or license status of an applicant for a license, a license holder, or an 10 11 individual who previously held a license. 12 (d) For a license issued under Chapter 42, 43, 103, or 161, 13 Human Resources Code, or Chapter 142, 242, 247, 248A, 250, or 252, Health and Safety Code, Subsection (b) does not prohibit the 14 15 disclosure of: 16 (1) the last four digits of the social security number of a license holder in connection with a verification of 17 18 employability or an employee misconduct registry search provided by the Health and Human Services Commission; 19 20 (2) a home address where activity regulated by the licensing authority occurs; or 21 22 (3) an e-mail address or phone number associated with activity regulated by the licensing authority. 23 (e) To the extent of any conflict, this section prevails 24 over another law that authorizes or requires the release of 25 information maintained by a governmental body. 26 SECTION 3. Subchapter D, Chapter 507, Occupations Code, is 27

1 amended by adding Section 507.161 to read as follows:

Sec. 507.161. CONFIDENTIALITY OF HOME ADDRESS AND TELEPHONE
NUMBER. Except as provided by Section 507.160(d), the home address
and telephone number of a license holder are confidential and not
subject to disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code.
SECTION 4. Section 552.1176(b), Government Code, is
repealed.

8 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 9 a request for public information received by a governmental body, 10 including the State Bar of Texas, or an officer for public 11 information on or after the effective date of this Act.

12 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
