1-25 relating to the issuance of a temporary teaching certificate to and
 1-26 requirements regarding educator certification for certain persons
 1-27 with experience as instructors for the Community College of the Air
 1-28 Force.

1-29 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-30 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 21, Education Code, is
 1-31 amended by adding Section 21.0525 to read as follows:

1-32 Sec. 21.0525. CERTIFICATION OF CERTAIN MILITARY
 1-33 INSTRUCTORS; TEMPORARY TEACHING CERTIFICATE. (a) The board shall
 1-34 propose rules providing for a person who has at least two semesters'
 1-35 experience as a full-time instructor for the Community College of
 1-36 the Air Force to:

1-37 (1) be issued a temporary teaching certificate on the
 1-38 person's enrollment in an educator preparation program; and

1-39 (2) receive credit for the person's education,
 1-40 training, and clinical or professional experience as an instructor
 1-41 for the Community College of the Air Force toward the requirements
 1-42 for completion of an educator preparation program, including
 1-43 requirements regarding coursework, field-based experience, or
 1-44 clinical experience.

1-45 (b) A temporary teaching certificate issued under this
 1-46 section is valid for a term of one year from the date of issuance.

1-47 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
