- 11 Sec. 113.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
- 12 (1) "Agricultural land" means land that qualifies for
- 13 tax appraisal under Subchapter C or D, Chapter 23, Tax Code.
- 14 (1-a) "Company" means a sole proprietorship,
- 15 organization, association, corporation, partnership, joint
- 16 venture, limited partnership, limited liability partnership, or
- 17 limited liability company, including a wholly owned subsidiary,
- 18 majority-owned subsidiary, parent company, or affiliate of those
- 19 entities or business associations, that exists to make a profit.
- 20 (2) "Critical infrastructure" means a communication

- 5 Sec. 113.002. PROHIBITED ACCESS TO CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE
- 6 AND AGRICULTURAL LAND. (a) A business entity or individual may not
- 7 <u>enter into an agreement relating to agricultural land in this state</u>
- 8 with individuals who are citizens of China, Iran, North Korea,
- 9 Russia, or a designated country.
- 10 (b) A business entity may not enter into an agreement
- 11 relating to critical infrastructure or agricultural land in this
- 12 state with a company:
- 13 (1) if, under the agreement, the company would be
- 14 granted direct or remote access to or control of critical
- 15 infrastructure or agricultural land in this state, excluding access
- 16 specifically allowed by the business entity for product warranty
- 17 and support purposes; and
- 18 (2) if the business entity knows that the company is:
- (A) owned by or the majority of stock or other

- 11 Sec. 113.003. DESIGNATION OF COUNTRY AS THREAT TO CRITICAL
- 12 INFRASTRUCTURE OR AGRICULTURAL LAND. (a) The governor, after
- 13 consultation with the public safety director of the Department of
- 14 Public Safety, may designate a country as a threat to critical
- 15 infrastructure or agricultural land for purposes of this chapter.
- 16 (b) The governor shall consult the Homeland Security
- 17 Council, established under Subchapter B, Chapter 421, Government
- 18 Code, to assess a threat to critical infrastructure or agricultural
- 19 land for purposes of making a designation under this section.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
