A state 13 14 officer who is elected in a statewide election may purchase one subscription to each periodical that is published in this state. 15 16 This subsection does not apply to a purchase for or by a state museum, a state library or archive, or an institution of higher 17
- 19 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 2113, Government Code, is 20 amended by adding Section 2113.108 to read as follows:
- Sec. 2113.108. NEWS MEDIA. Except as provided by Section 22 2113.107(h), a state agency may not use appropriated money to 23 sponsor, partner with, donate to, or otherwise provide financial 24 support to any news media.
