1 (5) developing, in coordination with state agencies, local governmental entities, and other entities operating or 2 exercising control over state information systems 3 state-controlled data, information security policies, standards, 4 and guidelines to strengthen this state's cybersecurity; 5 (6) overseeing the implementation of the policies, 6 7 standards, and guidelines developed under Subdivisions (3), (4), and (5); 8 (7) providing information security leadership, 9 strategic direction, and coordination for the state information 10 11 security program; (8) providing strategic direction to: 12 13 (A) the network security center established under Section 2059.101; and 14 15 (B) statewide technology centers operated under 16 Subchapter L; and 17 (9) overseeing the preparation and submission of the 18 report described by Section 2054.0591.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
