- 2 relating to the provision of information regarding mental health
- 3 and suicide prevention services to entering students at public

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 51.9194, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (a) An institution of higher education [A general academic
- 10 teaching institution] shall provide to each entering [full-time]
- 11 undergraduate, graduate, or professional student, including each
- 12 [full-time] undergraduate, graduate, or professional student who
- 13 transfers to the institution, information about:
- 14 (1) available mental health and suicide prevention
- 15 services offered by the institution or by any associated
- 16 organizations or programs; and
- 17 (2) early warning signs that are often present in and
- 18 appropriate intervention for a person who may be considering
- 19 suicide.
- 20 <u>(a-1) In this section, "institution of higher education"</u>
- 21 has the meaning assigned by Section 61.003.
- SECTION 2. Section 51.9194, Education Code, as amended by
- 23 this Act, applies beginning with the 2023-2024 academic year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
