1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to the maintenance of certain state buildings allocated
 1-24 for legislative use and their grounds.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Section 2165.007, Government Code, is amended by
 1-27 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

1-28 (c) Notwithstanding Subsection (b) and except as otherwise
 1-29 provided by this subsection, the State Preservation Board is
 1-30 responsible for providing general building and grounds maintenance
 1-31 for the Sam Houston Building, the Robert E. Johnson Building and the
 1-32 attached chiller utility plant and parking facility known as state
 1-33 parking garage P, and the John H. Reagan Building. The commission
 1-34 shall operate and maintain the central utility plant in the Sam
 1-35 Houston Building. This subsection may not be construed to
 1-36 specifically commit the control of any public buildings or grounds
 1-37 to the State Preservation Board for purposes of Section 2165.002 or
 1-38 any other law.

1-39 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
