Section 61.059, Education Code, is amended by 5 6 adding Subsection (n-1) to read as follows: 7 (n-1) In the formula applicable to Lamar State College--Orange for funding instruction and administration, the 8 board shall include any contact hours taught through distance 9 education to students enrolled at that college who reside in 10 another state and: 11 (1) as permitted by Section 54.231(a), pay tuition at 12 13 the rate charged to residents of this state; and 14 (2) reside in a county or parish in the other state 15 that is contiguous to the county in which the college is located. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 18

Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
