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S.B. No. 674

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to municipal and county building codes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Sections 388.003(a) and (b), Health and Safety 5 Code, are amended to read as follows:

6 (a) То achieve energy conservation in single-family residential construction, on January [the energy efficiency 7 chapter of the International Residential Code, as it existed on May 8 1, 2001, is adopted as the energy code in this state for 9 single-family residential construction. On September] 1, 2024 10 [2016], the energy efficiency chapter of the International 11 12 Residential Code, as it existed on May 1, 2023 [2015], is adopted as 13 the energy code in this state for single-family residential construction. On or after <u>January</u> [September] 1, 2030 [2021], the 14 15 State Energy Conservation Office may adopt and substitute for that energy code the latest published edition of the energy efficiency 16 chapter of the International Residential Code, based on written 17 findings on the stringency of the chapter submitted by the 18 laboratory under Subsection (b-3). The office: 19

(1) may not adopt an edition under this subsectionmore often than once every six years; and

(2) by rule shall establish an effective date for an
adopted edition that is not earlier than nine months after the date
of adoption.

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1 (b) To achieve energy conservation in all other 2 residential, commercial, and industrial construction, the International Energy Conservation Code as it existed on May 1, 2023 3 4 [2001], is adopted as the energy code for use in this state for all other residential, commercial, and industrial construction. 5 The State Energy Conservation Office may adopt and substitute for that 6 energy code the latest published edition of the International 7 Energy Conservation Code, based on written findings on the 8 9 stringency of the edition submitted by the laboratory under 10 Subsection (b-3). The office by rule shall establish an effective 11 date for an adopted edition that is not earlier than nine months 12 after the date of adoption.

13 SECTION 2. Sections 214.212(a) and (d), Local Government 14 Code, are amended to read as follows:

(a) To protect the public health, safety, and welfare, the
International Residential Code, as it existed on May 1, <u>2023</u>
[2012], is adopted as a municipal residential building code in this
state.

(d) A municipality may review and consider amendments made
by the International Code Council to the International Residential
Code after May 1, 2023 [2012].

22 SECTION 3. Sections 214.214(a) and (c), Local Government 23 Code, are amended to read as follows:

(a) Except as provided by Subsection (c), the National
Electrical Code, as it existed on May 1, <u>2023</u> [2001], is adopted as
the municipal electrical construction code in this state and
applies to all residential and commercial electrical construction

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1 applications.

(c) The National Electrical Code applies to all commercial
buildings in a municipality for which construction begins on or
after January 1, <u>2024</u> [2006], and to any alteration, remodeling,
enlargement, or repair of those commercial buildings.

6 SECTION 4. Sections 214.216(a) and (d), Local Government 7 Code, are amended to read as follows:

8 (a) To protect the public health, safety, and welfare, the 9 International Building Code, as it existed on May 1, <u>2023</u> [2012], is 10 adopted as a municipal commercial building code in this state.

(d) A municipality may review and consider amendments made by the International Code Council to the International Building Code after May 1, <u>2023</u> [2012].

SECTION 5. Section 233.062(c), Local Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

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(c) The fire code must:

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(1) conform to:

(A) the International Fire Code, as published by
the International Code Council, as the code existed on May 1, 2023
[2005]; or

(B) the Uniform Fire Code, as published by the
 National Fire Protection Association, as the code existed on May 1,
 2023 [2005]; or

24 (2) establish protective measures that exceed the25 standards of the codes described by Subdivision (1).

26 SECTION 6. Section 233.153(a), Local Government Code, is 27 amended to read as follows:

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1 New residential construction of a single-family house (a) 2 or duplex in the unincorporated area of a county to which this subchapter applies shall conform to the version of the 3 4 International Residential Code published as of May 1, 2023 [2008], or the version of the International Residential Code that 5 is applicable in the county seat of that county. 6

7 SECTION 7. Section 233.153(b), Local Government Code, is
8 repealed.

9 SECTION 8. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to residential or commercial construction, remodeling, alteration, 10 11 enlargement, repair, or other activity, as applicable, that begins 12 under an agreement entered into on or after January 1, 2024, or that 13 begins, in the absence of an agreement, on or after that date. Residential or commercial construction, remodeling, alteration, 14 15 enlargement, repair, or other applicable activity that begins under 16 an agreement entered into before January 1, 2024, or that begins, in the absence of an agreement, before that date is governed by the law 17 in effect when the agreement was entered into or the activity began, 18 as appropriate, and that law is continued in effect for that 19 20 purpose.

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SECTION 9. This Act takes effect January 1, 2024.
