A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the inspection periods for certain motor vehicles;
- 3 increasing certain fees.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 382.202(d), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d) On adoption of a resolution by the commission and after
- 8 proper notice, the Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas
- 9 shall implement a system that requires, [as a condition of
- 10 obtaining a passing vehicle inspection report issued under
- 11 Subchapter C, Chapter 548, Transportation Code, in a county that
- 12 is included in a vehicle emissions inspection and maintenance
- 13 program under Subchapter F, Chapter 548, Transportation Code [of
- 14 that chapter], that a motor vehicle registered in this state [the
- 15 vehicle], unless the vehicle is not covered by the system, be
- 16 annually or biennially inspected under the vehicle emissions
- 17 inspection and maintenance program as required by the state's air
- 18 quality state implementation plan. The Department of Public Safety
- 19 shall implement such a system when it is required by any provision
- 20 of federal or state law, including any provision of the state's air
- 21 quality state implementation plan.
- 22 SECTION 2. Section 548.101, Transportation Code, is amended
- 23 to read as follows:
- Sec. 548.101. GENERAL FIVE-YEAR [ONE-YEAR] INSPECTION

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- 1 PERIOD. Except as provided by Section 548.102, the department
- 2 shall require an [annual] inspection every five years. The
- 3 department shall set the periods of inspection and may make rules
- 4 with respect to those periods. [The rules must provide that:
- 5 [(1) a vehicle owner may obtain an inspection not
- 6 earlier than 90 days before the date of expiration of the vehicle's
- 7 registration; and
- 8 [(2) a used motor vehicle sold by a dealer, as defined
- 9 by Section 503.001, must be inspected in the 180 days preceding the
- 10 date the dealer sells the vehicle.
- 11 SECTION 3. The heading to Section 548.102, Transportation
- 12 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 548.102. FIVE-YEAR [TWO-YEAR] INITIAL INSPECTION
- 14 PERIOD FOR PASSENGER CAR OR LIGHT TRUCK.
- SECTION 4. Section 548.102(a), Transportation Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 (a) The initial inspection period is five [two] years for a
- 18 passenger car or light truck that:
- 19 (1) is sold in this state or purchased by a commercial
- 20 fleet buyer described by Section 501.0234(b)(4) for use in this
- 21 state;
- 22 (2) has not been previously registered in this or
- 23 another state; and
- 24 (3) on the date of sale is of the current or preceding
- 25 model year.
- SECTION 5. Subchapter C, Chapter 548, Transportation Code,
- 27 is amended by adding Section 548.106 to read as follows:

- 1 Sec. 548.106. TIMING OF INSPECTION FOR REGISTRATION-BASED
- 2 ENFORCEMENT. The department shall require a vehicle required to be
- 3 inspected under this chapter to pass the required inspection:
- 4 (1) for initial registration, not earlier than 90 days
- 5 before the date of registration;
- 6 (2) for a renewal of registration, not earlier than 90
- 7 days before the date of expiration of the vehicle's registration;
- 8 (3) if the vehicle is a used motor vehicle sold by a
- 9 dealer, as defined by Section 503.001, in the 180 days preceding the
- 10 date the dealer sells the vehicle; or
- 11 (4) if the vehicle is subject to the federal motor
- 12 carrier safety regulations, in a period that complies with those
- 13 <u>regulations.</u>
- 14 SECTION 6. Section 548.254, Transportation Code, is amended
- 15 to read as follows:
- Sec. 548.254. VALIDITY OF VEHICLE INSPECTION REPORT. The
- 17 department, and the conservation commission if necessary, by rule
- 18 shall establish the length of time a [A] vehicle inspection report
- 19 required by this chapter is valid [invalid after the end of the 12th
- 20 month following the month in which the report is issued].
- 21 SECTION 7. Sections 548.501(a) and (b), Transportation
- 22 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 23 (a) Except as provided by Sections 548.503 and 548.504, the
- 24 fee for inspection of a [motor] vehicle other than a moped is \$26.50
- 25 [\$12.50]. The fee for inspection of a moped is \$19.75 [\$5.75].
- 26 (b) Out of each fee for an inspection, $$19.50 \ [\$5.50]$ shall
- 27 be remitted to the state under Section 548.509.

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- 1 SECTION 8. Section 548.502, Transportation Code, is amended
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 548.502. INSPECTION BY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR STATE
- 4 AGENCY. A political subdivision or state agency for which the
- 5 department certifies an inspection station under Section 548.004:
- 6 (1) shall pay to the state $\frac{$27.50}{$}$ [\$5.50] for each
- 7 inspection under Section 548.509; and
- 8 (2) may not be required to pay the remainder of the
- 9 inspection fee.
- SECTION 9. Section 548.503, Transportation Code, is amended
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 548.503. INITIAL FIVE-YEAR [TWO-YEAR] INSPECTION OF
- 13 PASSENGER CAR OR LIGHT TRUCK. (a) The fee for inspection of a
- 14 passenger car or light truck under Section 548.102 shall be set by
- 15 the department by rule on or before September 1 of each year. A fee
- 16 set by the department under this subsection must be based on the
- 17 costs of providing inspections and administering the program, but
- 18 may not be less than \$32.25 [$\frac{$21.75}{}$].
- 19 (b) Out of each fee for an inspection under this section,
- 20 \$25.25 [\$14.75] shall be remitted to the state under Section
- 21 548.509.
- 22 SECTION 10. Section 548.505, Transportation Code, is
- 23 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 548.505. EMISSIONS-RELATED INSPECTION FEE. (a) The
- 25 department by rule may impose an emissions-related inspection fee
- 26 for a vehicle inspected under Section 548.301(a) [in addition to
- 27 the fee provided by Section 548.501, 548.502, 548.503, or 548.504].

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- 1 A fee imposed under this subsection must be based on the costs of:
- 2 (1) providing inspections; and
- 3 (2) administering the program.
- 4 (b) The department may provide a maximum fee for an
- 5 inspection under this section [subchapter]. The department may not
- 6 set a minimum fee for an inspection under this section
- 7 [subchapter].
- 8 SECTION 11. Section 548.508, Transportation Code, is
- 9 amended to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 548.508. DISPOSITION OF FEES. Except as provided by
- 11 Sections 382.0622 and 382.202, Health and Safety Code, and <u>Sections</u>
- 12 [Section] 548.5055 and 548.510 of this code, each fee remitted to
- 13 the comptroller under this subchapter shall be deposited to the
- 14 credit of the Texas mobility fund.
- 15 SECTION 12. Section 548.509, Transportation Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 548.509. COLLECTION OF FEE DURING REGISTRATION. (a)
- 18 The Texas Department of Motor Vehicles or a county
- 19 assessor-collector that registers a motor vehicle that is subject
- 20 to an inspection fee under this chapter or Section 382.202, Health
- 21 and Safety Code, shall collect at the time of registration of the
- 22 motor vehicle the portion of the inspection fee that is required to
- 23 be remitted to the state.
- 24 (b) The Texas Department of Motor Vehicles or the county
- 25 assessor-collector shall remit the fee to the comptroller.
- SECTION 13. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
