5	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 29.9081 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 29.9081. PUBLIC SAFETY DUAL CREDIT GRANT PROGRAM. (a)
8	From funds appropriated or otherwise available for the purpose, the
9	agency shall establish and administer a program to provide grants
10	to eligible students who enroll while in high school in a dual
11	credit public safety degree or certificate program at a public
12	institution of higher education.
13	(b) The commissioner by rule shall establish eligibility
14	criteria to receive a grant under this section. The criteria must:
15	(1) require a student to enter into an agreement with
16	the agency to:
17	(A) complete the student's public safety degree
18	or certificate program within a period prescribed by commissioner
19	rule; and
20	(B) on completion of the student's degree or
21	certificate program and any other prerequisites for employment as a
22	peace officer or other public safety officer in this state,
23	complete a number of years of employment as a peace officer or other
24	public safety officer in this state, as prescribed by commissioner

2	(2) provide that a student who establishes initial
3	eligibility for a grant under this section remains eligible for a
4	grant under this section for the duration of the student's
5	enrollment in a public safety degree or certificate program at a
6	public institution of higher education as long as the student
7	continues to:
8	(A) make satisfactory academic progress toward
9	the degree or certificate; and
10	(B) meet other requirements prescribed by
11	commissioner rule.
12	(c) The amount of a grant awarded to a student under this
13	section is equal to the cost of tuition and required fees incurred
14	by the student for enrollment in a public safety degree or
15	certificate program at a public institution of higher education.
16	(d) A student receiving a grant under this section may use
17	the money only to pay the cost of tuition and required fees incurred
18	by the student for enrollment in a public safety degree or
19	certificate program at a public institution of higher education.
20	(e) The agency may solicit and accept gifts, grants, and
21	donations from any public or private source for the purpose of this
22	section.
23	(f) The commissioner shall adopt rules to establish and
24	administer the grant program under this section.
25	SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
26	of this Act, the Texas Education Agency shall establish the public
27	safety dual credit grant program under Section 29.9081, Education

2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
