AN ACT 1 2 relating to an animal share exemption for certain meat and meat food 3 products; providing a civil penalty. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 433, Health and Safety 5 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 433.0065 to read as follows: 7 Sec. 433.0065. ANIMAL SHARE EXEMPTION; CIVIL PENALTY. (a) In this section, "animal share" means an ownership interest in one 8 or more identified livestock animals created by a contract between 9 10 a farmer or rancher who owns the livestock and a prospective co-owner of the livestock. 11 12 (b) An animal share executed by a co-owner and a farmer or 13 rancher under this section must include: 14 (1) a bill of sale the farmer or rancher provides to 15 the co-owner conveying an ownership interest in the livestock; (2) a provision authorizing the farmer or rancher to 16 17 board the livestock and arrange preparation of the livestock as meat and meat food products for the co-owner; and 18 19 (3) a provision entitling the co-owner to a share of meat and meat food products derived from the livestock. 20 (c) The provisions of this chapter requiring inspection of 21

livestock before slaughter and inspection of the preparation of

meat and meat food products do not apply to the slaughter of

livestock and preparation of meat and meat food products if:

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1	(1) ownership of the livestock under an animal share
2	is established before the livestock is slaughtered and the meat and
3	meat food products are prepared;
4	(2) the meat and meat food products are:
5	(A) prepared from livestock subject to an animal
6	share and delivered to the establishment preparing the products by
7	the farmer or rancher boarding the livestock; and
8	(B) following preparation, delivered directly to
9	the co-owner;
10	(3) on delivery of the meat or meat food products to
11	the co-owner, the establishment provides to the co-owner notice
12	that the department has not inspected the meat or meat food products
13	<u>in:</u>
14	(A) a separate written statement that
15	prominently displays the warning; or
16	(B) a warning statement prominently displayed on
17	a label affixed to the meat or meat food product packaging;
18	(4) the label affixed to the meat or meat food product
19	clearly and conspicuously states "Not for Sale"; and
20	(5) the farmer or rancher provides to the co-owner
21	information describing the standards the farmer or rancher followed
22	in maintaining livestock health and preparing the meat and meat
23	food products derived from the livestock.
24	(d) A person may not sell, donate, or commercially
25	redistribute meat or meat food products produced in accordance with
26	this section. A person who violates this subsection is liable to
27	this state for a civil penalty in the amount of \$10,000 for each

- 1 violation. The attorney general may bring an action to recover a
- 2 civil penalty authorized under this subsection and may recover
- 3 reasonable expenses incurred in obtaining the civil penalty,
- 4 including court costs, attorney's fees, investigative costs,
- 5 witness fees, and deposition expenses.
- 6 (e) A farmer or rancher may not publish a statement that
- 7 implies department approval or endorsement regarding meat or meat
- 8 food products delivered pursuant to an animal share.
- 9 (f) The adulteration and misbranding provisions of this
- 10 chapter, other than the requirement of an inspection legend, apply
- 11 to meat or meat food products prepared by a processing
- 12 establishment under this section.
- 13 (g) This section does not authorize the preparation of meat
- 14 or meat food products in violation of the Federal Meat Inspection
- 15 Act (21 U.S.C. Section 601 et seq.).
- SECTION 2. Section 433.024(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 (b) The department shall inspect each slaughtering
- 19 establishment whose primary business is the selling of livestock to
- 20 be slaughtered by the purchaser on premises owned or operated by the
- 21 seller. This subsection does not nullify the provisions in Section
- 22 433.006 relating to exemptions or Section 433.0065 relating to an
- 23 <u>animal share exemption</u>.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
