1	AN ACT
2	relating to an animal share exemption for certain meat and meat food
3	products; providing a civil penalty.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 433, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 433.0065 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 433.0065. ANIMAL SHARE EXEMPTION; CIVIL PENALTY. (a)
8	In this section, "animal share" means an ownership interest in
9	livestock created by a contract between a consumer and a farmer or
10	rancher who owns the livestock.
11	(b) An animal share executed by a consumer and a farmer or
12	rancher under this section must include:
13	(1) a bill of sale the farmer or rancher provides to
14	the consumer conveying to the consumer an ownership interest in the
15	<pre>livestock;</pre>
16	(2) a provision authorizing the farmer or rancher to
17	board the livestock and arrange preparation of the livestock as
18	meat and meat food products for the consumer; and

- 19 (3) a provision entitling the consumer to a share of
- meat and meat food products derived from the livestock. 20
- 21 (c) The provisions of this chapter requiring inspection of
- livestock before slaughter and inspection of the preparation of 22
- 23 meat and meat food products do not apply to the slaughter of
- livestock and preparation of meat and meat food products if: 24

1	(1) ownership of the livestock under an animal share
2	is established before the livestock is slaughtered and the meat and
3	<pre>meat food products are prepared;</pre>
4	(2) the meat and meat food products are:
5	(A) prepared from livestock subject to an animal
6	share and delivered to the establishment preparing the products by
7	the farmer or rancher boarding the livestock; and
8	(B) following preparation, delivered directly to
9	the consumer who owns the animal share;
10	(3) on delivery of the meat or meat food products to
11	the consumer, the establishment provides to the consumer notice
12	that the department has not inspected the meat or meat food products
13	<u>in:</u>
14	(A) a separate written statement that
15	prominently displays the warning; or
16	(B) a warning statement prominently displayed on
17	a label affixed to the meat or meat food product packaging; and
18	(4) the farmer or rancher provides to the consumer
19	information describing the standards the farmer or rancher followed
20	in maintaining livestock health and preparing the meat and meat
21	food products derived from the livestock.
22	(d) A consumer may not sell, donate, or commercially
23	redistribute meat or meat food products delivered to the consumer
24	in accordance with this section. A person who violates this
25	subsection is liable to this state for a civil penalty in the amount
26	of \$10,000 for each violation. The attorney general may bring an
27	action to recover a civil penalty authorized under this subsection

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- 1 and may recover reasonable expenses incurred in obtaining the civil
- 2 penalty, including court costs, attorney's fees, investigative
- 3 costs, witness fees, and deposition expenses.
- 4 (e) A farmer or rancher may not publish a statement that
- 5 implies department approval or endorsement regarding meat or meat
- 6 food products delivered pursuant to an animal share.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 433.024(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 8 amended to read as follows:
- 9 (b) The department shall inspect each slaughtering
- 10 establishment whose primary business is the selling of livestock to
- 11 be slaughtered by the purchaser on premises owned or operated by the
- 12 seller. This subsection does not nullify the provisions in Section
- 13 433.006 relating to exemptions or Section 433.0065 relating to an
- 14 animal share exemption.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
