- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 95A, Civil Practice and Remedies Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 95A.0002 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 95A.0002. LIABILITY OF BUSINESS IN CONNECTION WITH
- 8 PROHIBITING HANDGUNS. (a) In this section, "license holder" means
- 9 <u>a person licensed to carry a handgun under Subchapter H, Chapter</u>
- 10 411, Government Code.
- 11 (b) A person with control over the premises of a business
- 12 who prohibits entry on the premises by a license holder with a
- 13 concealed handgun by posting a sign on the premises as described by
- 14 Section 30.06, Penal Code, is liable for damages arising from a
- 15 criminal act occurring on the premises.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of
- 18 this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
