1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the granting of privileges to and the authority of  
1-22 podiatrists at hospitals.  
1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
1-24 SECTION 1. Section [241.102](#), Health and Safety Code, is  
1-25 amended by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (f) to  
1-26 read as follows:  
1-27 (c) An applicant for medical staff membership or privileges  
1-28 may not be denied membership or privileges solely on the ground that  
1-29 the applicant is a podiatrist rather than a physician.  
1-30 (f) This section does not authorize a podiatrist to practice  
1-31 beyond the scope of the podiatrist's license to practice podiatry.  
1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
