4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:		
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 33, Education Code, is		
6	amended by adding Section 33.911 to read as follows:		
7	Sec. 33.911. STATEWIDE IMAGINATION LIBRARY PROGRAM. (a)		
8	In this section, "board" means the State Board of Education.		
9	(b) Using money described by Subsection (d), the board shall		
10	establish a statewide Imagination Library program in partnership		
11	with Dolly Parton's Imagination Library or a similar book		
12	distribution program to encourage children to develop a love of		
13	reading and learning by mailing age-appropriate books on a monthly		
14	basis to children five years of age or younger who register for the		
15	program.		
16	(c) The board shall:		
17	(1) identify and recruit local affiliates across the		
18	state to participate in the program;		
19	(2) assist local affiliates in the development,		
20	coordination, and promotion of the program in the affiliates'		
21	respective communities;		
22	(3) develop, coordinate, and promote a statewide		
23	public awareness campaign to inform:		
24	(A) donors regarding opportunities to

1	financially support the program and local affiliates; and
2	(B) the public regarding the program, including
3	how to register eligible children into the program; and
4	(4) coordinate the collection and remittance of
5	program costs for books and mailing.
6	(d) The board may solicit and accept gifts, grants, and
7	donations from any public or private source for purposes of the
8	program.
9	(e) The board may adopt rules as necessary to implement this
10	section.
11	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
