4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 2054, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 2054.0287 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 2054.0287. CHIEF PRIVACY OFFICER. (a) The executive
8	director shall employ a chief privacy officer to provide assistance
9	to state agencies on legal and policy matters involving data
10	privacy. The chief privacy officer shall:
11	(1) conduct a biennial privacy review that compiles
12	information about the data privacy practices of state agencies,
13	including, for each agency, information about:
14	(A) the specific privacy policies implemented;
15	(B) the type of data collected;
16	(C) how the data collected by the agency is
17	obtained, shared, secured, stored, and discarded;
18	(D) the persons with whom the agency shares the
19	data; and
20	(E) how the agency deidentifies or anonymizes the
21	data;
22	(2) develop and implement best practices among state
23	agencies to ensure compliance with privacy laws;
24	(3) provide state agencies and their employees with

- 1 guidance related to best practices on data privacy; and
- 2 (4) coordinate data protection in cooperation with the
- 3 chief information officer and the chief data officer described by
- 4 Sections 2054.0285 and 2054.0286, respectively.
- 5 (b) Each state agency shall cooperate with the chief privacy
- 6 officer in fulfilling the requirements of this section.
- 7 (c) The chief privacy officer may assist local governments
- 8 and the public with data privacy and protection concerns by:
- 9 (1) developing and promoting the dissemination of best
- 10 practices for the collection and storage of personally identifiable
- 11 information, including establishing and conducting training
- 12 programs for local governments; and
- 13 (2) educating consumers about the use of personally
- 14 <u>identifiable information on mobile and digit</u>al networks and
- 15 measures that can help protect the user's data.
- 16 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 17 of this Act, the executive director of the Department of
- 18 Information Resources shall employ a chief privacy officer as
- 19 required by Section 2054.0287, Government Code, as added by this
- 20 Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
