- 2 relating to increasing the minimum term of imprisonment for certain
- 3 felony offenses in which a firearm is used or exhibited.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 12, Penal Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 12.502 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 12.502. PENALTY FOR CERTAIN FELONY OFFENSES COMMITTED
- 8 WITH FIREARM. (a) The minimum term of imprisonment for a first,
- 9 second, or third degree felony listed in Article 42A.054(a), Code
- 10 of Criminal Procedure, is increased to 10 years if an affirmative
- 11 finding has been entered in the judgment in the case under Article
- 12 42A.054(d), Code of Criminal Procedure.
- (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to a felony offense for
- 14 which the punishment otherwise required by law includes a minimum
- 15 term of imprisonment that exceeds 10 years.
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 18 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 19 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 20 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 21 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 22 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 23 before that date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
