- 8 that is related to a risk located entirely in this state must be
- 9 conducted in this state, and the insurance contract, including the
- 10 <u>arbitration agreement, must be interpreted in accordance with the</u>
- 11 laws of this state. This subsection may not be construed as a
- 12 defense to the enforcement of:
- 13 (1) an arbitration agreement that complies with or has
- 14 been reformed to comply with this subsection; or
- 15 (2) an award made under an agreement described by
- 16 Subdivision (1).
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 981.101(d), Insurance Code, as added by
- 18 this Act, applies only to an arbitration commenced on or after the
- 19 effective date of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
