4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 325, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Section 325.0124 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 325.0124. REVIEW OF AGENCY'S SALE OF PERSONAL DATA.
8	(a) In this section, "personal data" means any information
9	relating to an identified or identifiable individual that directly
10	or indirectly identifies the individual by reference to:
11	(1) an identifier for the individual, including a
12	name, an identification number, location information, or an online
13	identifier; or
14	(2) one or more factors specific to the physical,
15	physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural, or social
16	identity of the individual.
17	(b) As part of its review of a state agency, the commission
18	shall determine whether the state agency sells personal data the
19	agency possesses. If the state agency sells personal data, the
20	commission shall determine:

- (1) to whom the personal data is sold; 21
- (2) to the extent possible, the purpose for which the 22
- personal data is sold; 23
- (3) the amount the state agency receives for the sale 24

- 1 of the personal data; and
- 2 (4) the law that authorizes the state agency to sell
- 3 the personal data.
- 4 (c) The commission shall recommend prohibiting the sale of
- 5 personal data by a state agency, unless the commission identifies a
- 6 compelling state or public interest justifying the state agency's
- 7 authority to sell the personal data. If the commission recommends
- 8 continuing the state agency's authority to sell personal data, the
- 9 commission shall make any recommendations it considers necessary to
- 10 protect the personal data from improper use and dissemination.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
