14	(1) the appeal relates only to a claim of excessive
15	appraisal of property that qualifies as the owner's residence
16	homestead; and
17	(2) the appraised value of the property as determined
18	by the appraisal review board and stated in the order being appealed
19	<u>is \$500,000 or less.</u>
20	(b) Venue of an action brought under Section 42.01(a)(1) in

- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to the
- 14 appeal of an order of an appraisal review board without regard to
- 15 whether the order was issued before the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
