- 9 and annual reports of the corporation's financial activity and

- 11 corporation's registered or principal office in this state for at
- 12 least three years after the close of the fiscal year.
- 13 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), the [The]

- 15 the public for inspection and copying at the corporation's
- 16 registered or principal office during regular business hours. The
- 17 corporation may charge a reasonable fee for preparing a copy of a

- 19 <u>(c) A corporation is exempt from Subsection (b) if:</u>
- 20 <u>(1) an independent certified public accountant has</u>

- 2 corporation's financial activity kept under Subsection (a)
- 3 available to the public for inspection and copying at the

- 5 business hours. The corporation may charge a reasonable fee for
- 6 preparing a copy of a statement or report.
- 7 (d) A corporation shall make an audited financial statement
- 8 described by Subsection (c)(1) available to the public for
- 9 inspection and copying not later than the 180th day after the close
- 10 of the fiscal year to which the audit relates.
