4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 411, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Subchapter B-2 to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER B-2. WITNESS PROTECTION UNIT
8	Sec. 411.0281. In this subchapter:
9	(1) "Prosecuting attorney" has the meaning assigned
10	under Section 411.0251.
11	(2) "Unit" and "witness protection unit" mean the
12	witness protection unit established under Section 411.0282.
13	Sec. 411.0282. ESTABLISHMENT OF UNIT. The Texas Rangers
14	division of the department shall establish and support a witness
15	<pre>protection unit.</pre>
16	Sec. 411.0283. PURPOSE AND DUTIES. (a) On receiving a
17	request from a prosecuting attorney or a prosecuting attorney's

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- designee qualified under Section 411.0286(b) to make such a 18
- request, the unit may provide for the relocation or other 19
- 20 protection of:
- 21 (1) a witness or prospective witness in a criminal
- 22 case in this state:
- 23 (A) for an offense punishable as a first degree
- 24 or capital felony; or

- 1 (B) in which the witness or prospective witness
- 2 is likely to be subject to obstruction or retaliation under Section
- 3 36.06, Penal Code, as determined by the unit; or
- 4 (2) a family member or person otherwise closely
- 5 associated with a witness or prospective witness described by
- 6 Subdivision (1), if the unit determines that the family member or
- 7 person may be in danger of harm as a result of the witness's or
- 8 prospective witness's participation in the criminal case.
- 9 (b) The department may adopt rules necessary for the
- 10 establishment and administration of the unit, including rules
- 11 relating to:
- 12 (1) the types of cases for which the unit may protect a
- 13 witness or prospective witness;
- 14 (2) the process the unit will use to approve a request
- 15 for witness protection;
- 16 (3) the types of protection services the unit will
- 17 offer; and
- 18 (4) protocols that ensure the confidentiality and
- 19 security of witness information.
- Sec. 411.0284. GIFTS, GRANTS, AND DONATIONS. The
- 21 department may solicit and accept gifts, grants, and donations from
- 22 any source for the purpose of implementing this subchapter.
- Sec. 411.0285. IMMUNITY FROM LIABILITY. The Texas Rangers,
- 24 the department, or another authorized agent of the unit is not
- 25 liable for damages resulting from witness protection provided or a
- 26 request for witness protection denied under this subchapter.
- 27 <u>Sec. 411.0286.</u> <u>PROSECUTING ATTORNEY TRAINING.</u> (a) The

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- 1 unit shall develop and provide a training course for prosecuting
- 2 attorneys and the prosecuting attorneys' designees regarding:
- 3 (1) witness protection procedures and best practices;
- 4 (2) the types of cases for which the unit may protect a
- 5 witness or prospective witness; and
- 6 (3) the process the unit will use to approve a request
- 7 for witness protection.
- 8 (b) To be qualified to request assistance from the unit, a
- 9 prosecuting attorney or a prosecuting attorney's designee must have
- 10 completed the training course described by Subsection (a).
- 11 (c) The department shall offer the training course
- 12 described by Subsection (a) at least once every two years.
- SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2023, the Department
- 14 of Public Safety shall establish the witness protection unit under
- 15 Subchapter B-2, Chapter 411, Government Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
