A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to subdivision plat requirements for certain counties 3 located near the international border. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 232.023(b), Local Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (b) A plat required under this section must: be certified by a surveyor or engineer registered 8 (1) 9 to practice in this state; (2) define the subdivision by metes and bounds; 10 11 (3) locate the subdivision with respect to an original 12 corner of the original survey of which it is a part; 13 (4) describe each lot, number each lot in progression, 14 [and] give the dimensions of each lot, and provide an address for each lot sufficient for the provision of 9-1-1 services; 15 (5) state the dimensions of and accurately describe 16 each lot, street, alley, square, park, or other part of the tract 17 intended to be dedicated to public use or for the use of purchasers 18 or owners of lots fronting on or adjacent to the street, alley, 19 square, park, or other part; 20 21 (6) include or have attached a document containing a 22 description in English and Spanish of the water and sewer 23 facilities and roadways and easements dedicated for the provision of water and sewer facilities that will be constructed or installed 24

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meet, or will meet, the minimum requirements of state standards; 1 2 (C) electrical connections provided to the lot meet, or will meet, the minimum state standards; and 3 4 (D) gas connections, if available, provided to 5 the lot meet, or will meet, the minimum state standards. 6 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to a plat application filed on or after the effective date of this 7 8 Act.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
