 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to fire escape exemptions for certain courthouses.  
 1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 791.004, Health and Safety Code, is  
 1-24 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:  
 1-25 (c) This chapter does not apply to a county courthouse that:  
 1-26 (1) was constructed before September 1, 1989; and  
 1-27 (2) is located in a county with a population of less  
 1-28 than 50,000.  
 1-29 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-30 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-31 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-32 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-33 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
