- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 205.303, Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 205.303. ACUDETOX SPECIALIST. (a) The medical board 7
- may certify a person as an acudetox specialist under this section if 8
- 9 the person:

- (1) provides to the medical board documentation that 10

- 12 (A) is a licensed social worker, licensed
- professional counselor, including a person licensed under Section 13
- 14 503.308, licensed psychologist, licensed chemical dependency
- counselor, licensed marriage and family therapist, licensed 15

- nurse, [or] licensed registered nurse, licensed physician 17
- assistant, or other licensed or certified professional approved by 18
- the medical board; and 19
- (B) has successfully completed a training 20
- 21 program in <u>auricular acudetox</u> [acupuncture detoxification] that
- meets or exceeds the training [guidelines] approved by the medical 22
- 23 board; and
- 24 (2) pays a certification fee in an amount set by the

- 2 (b) An acudetox specialist may practice five-point
- 3 auricular acupuncture only[+
- 4 $\left[\frac{(1)}{(1)}\right]$ to the extent allowed by rules adopted by the
- 5 medical board for the treatment of addiction, trauma, or physical,
- 6 emotional, or psychological stress [alcoholism, substance abuse,
- 7 or chemical dependency; and
- 8 [(2) under the supervision of a licensed acupuncturist
- 9 or physician].
- 10 (c) An [A program that includes the services of an] acudetox
- 11 specialist shall:
- 12 (1) obtain informed consent from each client and
- 13 notify each client [participant in the program] of the
- 14 qualifications of the acudetox specialist and of the procedure for

- 16 medical board; and
- 17 (2) keep a record of each client's name and $[\tau]$ the date

- 21 (d) The [medical board may annually renew the]
- 22 certification of an acudetox specialist <u>expires</u> on the third
- 23 <u>anniversary of the date of issuance and may be renewed before the</u>
- 24 <u>expiration of the certification</u> [under this section] if the person:

- 1 (B) the person has successfully met continuing
- 2 education requirements established by the medical board under
- 3 Subsection (e); and
- 4 (2) pays a certification renewal fee in an amount set
- 5 by the medical board.
- 6 (e) The medical board by rule shall establish continuing
- 7 education requirements for an acudetox specialist [that, at a
- 8 minimum, include six hours of education in the practice of
- 9 acupuncture and a course in either clean needle technique or
- 10 universal infection control precaution procedures]. The board
- 11 shall require in rules adopted under this subsection that the
- 12 certification of an acudetox specialist may not be renewed unless
- 13 the person completes at least three hours of continuing education
- 14 developed by the board in the licensing period before applying for
- 15 <u>the renewal.</u>
- SECTION 2. Section 205.303(a), Occupations Code, as amended
- 17 by this Act, applies only to an application for certification or
- 18 renewal of certification as an acudetox specialist submitted on or
- 19 after the effective date of this Act. An application submitted
- 20 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 21 effect on the date the application was submitted, and the former law
- 22 is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
