8	Subject to Subsection (b), not [The comptroller shall provide
9	copies, including electronic form copies, of any reports received
10	<pre>from a consultant contracting under Section 2115.002 to:</pre>
11	[(1) the governor;
12	(2) the state auditor's office; and
13	(3) the Legislative Budget Board.
14	[(b) The comptroller shall provide the copies required by
15	Subsection (a) not later than the 15th day after the date the
16	comptroller receives the consultant's report.
17	[(c) Not] later than February 1 of each odd-numbered year,
18	the comptroller shall issue $[\frac{a-report}{}]$ to the legislature,
19	governor, state auditor's office, and Legislative Budget Board a
20	report summarizing the activities conducted by a consultant
21	pursuant to a recovery audit under this chapter during the
22	<pre>preceding state fiscal biennium [ending August 31 of the previous</pre>
23	year].
24	(b) The comptroller is required to issue a report under

- 2 chapter during the preceding state fiscal biennium.
