4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 5, Alcoholic Beverage
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 5.61 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 5.61. TRAINING PROGRAM ON OPIOID-RELATED DRUG
8	OVERDOSE. (a) In this section, "opioid antagonist" and
9	"opioid-related drug overdose" have the meanings assigned by
10	Section 483.101, Health and Safety Code.
11	(b) The commission shall develop a training program that
12	provides training on:
13	(1) the signs and symptoms of an opioid-related drug
14	overdose; and
15	(2) the administration of an opioid antagonist.
16	(c) The commission may make the training available online.
17	SECTION 2. Chapter 28, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended
18	by adding Section 28.20 to read as follows:
19	Sec. 28.20. TRAINING PROGRAM ON OPIOID-RELATED DRUG
20	OVERDOSE. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), the holder of
21	a mixed beverage permit and each employee of the permit holder who
22	is required by the permit holder to complete a commission-approved
23	seller training program shall complete the opioid-related drug
24	overdose training program described by Section 5.61 each year.

1	(b) This section does not apply to a mixed beverage permit
2	holder that is a restaurant as defined by Section 1.04.
3	SECTION 3. Chapter 32, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended
4	by adding Section 32.26 to read as follows:
5	Sec. 32.26. TRAINING PROGRAM ON OPIOID-RELATED DRUG
6	OVERDOSE. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), the holder of
7	a private club registration permit and each employee of the permit
8	holder who is required by the permit holder to complete a
9	commission-approved seller training program shall complete the
10	opioid-related drug overdose training program described by Section
11	5.61 each year.
12	(b) This section does not apply to the holder of a private
13	club registration permit that is a restaurant as defined by Section
14	1.04.
15	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
