TRAINING PROGRAM ON OPIOID-RELATED DRUG OVERDOSE. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), the holder of 20 a mixed beverage permit and each employee of the permit holder who 21 22 is required by the permit holder to complete a commission-approved

seller training program shall complete the opioid-related drug

overdose training program described by Section 5.61 each year.

- 15 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
