- 2 relating to a temporary exemption from sales and use taxes for
- 3 certain clothing and footwear.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 151, Tax Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 151.3265 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 151.3265. CLOTHING AND FOOTWEAR FOR LIMITED PERIOD;
- 8 TEMPORARY EXEMPTION. (a) The sale of an article of clothing or
- 9 footwear to which Section 151.326 applies is exempted from the
- 10 taxes imposed by this chapter if:
- 11 (1) the sales price of the article is less than \$200;
- 12 and
- 13 (2) the sale takes place during the period beginning
- 14 at 12:01 a.m. Friday, October 13, 2023, and ending at 11:59 p.m.
- 15 Sunday, October 15, 2023.
- 16 (b) This section expires October 31, 2023.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not
- 18 affect tax liability accruing before the effective date of this
- 19 Act. That liability continues in effect as if this Act had not been
- 20 enacted, and the former law is continued in effect for the
- 21 collection of taxes due and for civil and criminal enforcement of
- 22 the liability for those taxes.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
