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| 2 | relating to the regulation of electric vehicle supply equipment; |
| 3 | requiring an occupational registration; authorizing fees; |
| 4 | authorizing an administrative penalty. |
| 5 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: |
| 6 | SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 14, Occupations Code, is |
| 7 | amended by adding Chapter 2311 to read as follows: |
| 8 | CHAPTER 2311. ELECTRIC VEHICLE SUPPLY EQUIPMENT |
| 9 | SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS |
| 10 | Sec. 2311.0101. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter: |
| 11 | (1) "Commercial transaction" means any sale or |
| 12 | exchange for compensation of electrical energy through a digital |
| 13 | network. |
| 14 | (2) "Commission" means the Texas Commission of |
| 15 | Licensing and Regulation. |
| 16 | (3) "Department" means the Texas Department of |
| 17 | Licensing and Regulation. |
| 18 | (4) "Digital network" means an online-enabled |
| 19 | application, website, or system offered or used by an electric |
| 20 | vehicle charging provider that allows a user to initiate a |
| 21 | commercial transaction to dispense electrical energy from electric |
| 22 | vehicle supply equipment to an electric vehicle. |
| 23 | (5) "Electric vehicle supply equipment" means a device |
| 24 | or equipment used to dispense electrical energy to an electric |

- 1 <u>vehicle.</u>
- 2 (6) "Electric vehicle supply provider" means an owner
- 3 or operator of electric vehicle supply equipment that is available
- 4 and accessible to the public to provide electrical energy through a
- 5 commercial transaction.
- 6 <u>SUBCHAPTER B. POWERS AND DUTIES</u>
- 7 Sec. 2311.0201. RULES. The commission shall adopt rules as
- 8 necessary to implement this chapter.
- 9 Sec. 2311.0202. FEES. The commission by rule shall set fees
- 10 in amounts sufficient to cover the costs of administering this
- 11 chapter.
- 12 Sec. 2311.0203. CONTRACT. The department may contract to
- 13 perform the department's duties related to electric vehicle supply
- 14 equipment, including inspections. A reference in this chapter to
- 15 the commission or department in the context of a contracted service
- 16 means the contractor.
- 17 Sec. 2311.0204. INSPECTION OF ELECTRIC VEHICLE SUPPLY
- 18 EQUIPMENT. The department may periodically, or in response to a
- 19 complaint, conduct an inspection of electric vehicle supply
- 20 equipment in order to verify compliance with registration
- 21 requirements and standards established in this chapter and
- 22 commission rules, unless electric vehicle supply equipment is
- 23 exempt from the application of this chapter by commission rule.
- Sec. 2311.0205. COMPLAINTS REGARDING ELECTRIC VEHICLE
- 25 SUPPLY EQUIPMENT. In accordance with Chapter 51, the executive
- 26 director of the department shall establish methods by which
- 27 consumers are notified of the name, Internet website address,

- 1 mailing address, and telephone number of the department for the
- 2 purpose of directing complaints to the department.
- 3 Sec. 2311.0206. EXEMPTIONS. (a) The commission by rule may
- 4 exempt electric vehicle supply equipment from a requirement
- 5 established by this chapter if the commission determines that
- 6 imposing or enforcing the requirement:
- 7 (1) is not cost-effective for the department;
- 8 (2) is not feasible with current resources or
- 9 standards; or
- 10 (3) will not substantially benefit or protect
- 11 consumers.
- 12 (b) Electric vehicle supply equipment is exempt from the
- 13 requirements of this chapter if, in accordance with commission
- 14 rule, the electric vehicle supply equipment is:
- 15 (1) installed in or adjacent to a private residence
- 16 for noncommercial use; or
- 17 (2) provided at no charge for the exclusive use of an
- 18 individual, or a group of individuals, including employees,
- 19 tenants, visitors, or residents of a multiunit housing or office
- 20 development.
- 21 SUBCHAPTER C. OPERATION OF ELECTRIC VEHICLE SUPPLY EQUIPMENT
- Sec. 2311.0301. DUTIES OF ELECTRIC VEHICLE SUPPLY PROVIDER.
- 23 Unless electric vehicle supply equipment is exempt from the
- 24 application of this chapter or has been removed from service, an
- 25 electric vehicle supply provider shall:
- 26 (1) have electric vehicle supply equipment inspected
- 27 as prescribed by commission rule; and

- 1 (2) maintain electric vehicle supply equipment in
- 2 compliance with maintenance specifications, this chapter, and
- 3 commission rule.
- 4 Sec. 2311.0302. REQUIRED REGISTRATION. (a) Unless
- 5 electric vehicle supply equipment is exempt from the application of
- 6 this chapter by commission rule, an electric vehicle supply
- 7 provider shall register each charging unit of electric vehicle
- 8 supply equipment operated by the provider with the department
- 9 before the electric vehicle supply equipment is made available for
- 10 use on a digital network for a commercial transaction.
- 11 (b) The department shall issue a registration to each
- 12 applicant that meets the requirements of this chapter and submits
- 13 an application that meets the requirements of this section. An
- 14 application for electric vehicle supply equipment registration
- 15 must:
- 16 (1) be submitted to the department in a manner
- 17 prescribed by the department;
- 18 (2) be accompanied by any other document or form
- 19 required by the department;
- 20 (3) include any fee required under Section 2311.0202;
- 21 <u>and</u>
- 22 (4) include documentation of compliance with Section
- 23 2311.0303, as prescribed by commission rule.
- 24 (c) A registration under this section is valid for one or
- 25 two years as established by commission rule. The registration must
- 26 be renewed at or before the end of each registration period.
- Sec. 2311.0303. SPECIFICATIONS. (a) Specifications for the

- 1 installation and operation of electric vehicle supply equipment
- 2 must be the same as those recommended by the National Institute of
- 3 Standards and Technology.
- 4 (b) Electric vehicle supply equipment must be installed and
- 5 operated in accordance with Chapter 1305.
- 6 (c) The commission may adopt rules as necessary to establish
- 7 standards under this chapter.
- 8 Sec. 2311.0304. FEES; DISCLOSURES. (a) An electric
- 9 vehicle supply provider shall disclose on the display of the
- 10 electric vehicle supply equipment or on the electric vehicle supply
- 11 provider's digital network:
- 12 (1) the fee calculation method or methods; and
- 13 (2) applicable surcharges.
- 14 (b) Before the user begins charging, the electric vehicle
- 15 <u>supply provider shall disclose:</u>
- 16 (1) the rate the user will be charged at the time of
- 17 the transaction based on the available fee calculation method or
- 18 methods; and
- 19 (2) a list of applicable surcharges.
- 20 (c) In accordance with commission rule, an electric vehicle
- 21 supply provider shall show on the display of the provider's
- 22 electric vehicle supply equipment or on the provider's digital
- 23 network a notice to consumers that:
- 24 (1) states that the department regulates electric
- 25 vehicle supply equipment; and
- 26 (2) provides information on filing a complaint with
- 27 the department about electric vehicle supply equipment.

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- 1 Sec. 2311.0305. ELECTRONIC RECEIPT. After a reasonable
- 2 period following the completion of a commercial transaction for
- 3 electric vehicle charging, on request of a user, the electric
- 4 vehicle supply provider shall transmit an electronic summary that
- 5 includes:
- 6 (1) the date and time of the transaction;
- 7 (2) the physical location of the electric vehicle
- 8 supply equipment;
- 9 (3) the duration of and kilowatt hours provided during
- 10 the transaction; and
- 11 (4) an itemization of the total fees paid, including
- 12 surcharges, if applicable.
- Sec. 2311.0306. REPAIR OF DAMAGED ELECTRIC VEHICLE SUPPLY
- 14 EQUIPMENT. (a) An electric vehicle supply provider shall:
- 15 (1) remove from operation in a manner that prevents
- 16 use and access by the public, in accordance with commission rules,
- 17 electric vehicle supply equipment that poses a safety risk; and
- 18 (2) remove electric vehicle supply equipment that
- 19 poses a safety risk from the electric vehicle supply provider's
- 20 digital network listing of available charging units.
- 21 (b) If the department determines that electric vehicle
- 22 supply equipment poses a safety risk, the department shall place a
- 23 tag or other mark with the words "Out of Order" on the electric
- 24 vehicle supply equipment.
- 25 (c) An electric vehicle supply provider may not return
- 26 electric vehicle supply equipment to operation until the equipment
- 27 has been repaired in accordance with manufacturer specifications

1 and commission rule.

- 2 SUBCHAPTER D. ENFORCEMENT
- 3 <u>Sec. 2311.0401.</u> <u>DISCIPLINARY ACTION</u>. A person is subject
- 4 to the denial of an application, imposition of an administrative
- 5 penalty under Subchapter F, Chapter 51, or disciplinary action
- 6 under Section 51.353 if the person engages in a commercial
- 7 transaction in violation of this chapter or a rule adopted under
- 8 this chapter.
- 9 Sec. 2311.0402. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES. A proceeding
- 10 for the denial of a registration or a disciplinary action or an
- 11 appeal from that proceeding is governed by Chapter 2001, Government
- 12 Code.
- 13 SECTION 2. (a) The Texas Commission of Licensing and
- 14 Regulation shall adopt rules necessary to implement the changes in
- 15 law made by this Act not later than December 1, 2024.
- 16 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act,
- 17 electric vehicle supply equipment installed before December 31,
- 18 2023, is exempt from the requirements of Section 2311.0303,
- 19 Occupations Code, as added by this Act, until the fifth anniversary
- 20 of the date the rules described by Subsection (a) of this section
- 21 are adopted.
- 22 SECTION 3. (a) The Texas Department of Licensing and
- 23 Regulation may establish and lead a stakeholder work group to
- 24 provide input, advice, and recommendations on the activities under
- 25 this Act. The Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation shall
- 26 establish the size, composition, and scope of the stakeholder work
- 27 group.

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- 1 (b) This section expires on December 1, 2024.
- 2 SECTION 4. (a) An electric vehicle supply provider shall
- 3 register all of the provider's electric vehicle supply equipment in
- 4 operation in this state not later than March 1, 2025.
- 5 (b) Electric vehicle supply equipment installed in this
- 6 state before the effective date of this Act must be operated in
- 7 compliance with manufacturer specifications, Chapter 2311,
- 8 Occupations Code, as added by this Act, and Texas Commission of
- 9 Licensing and Regulation rules not later than March 1, 2026.
- 10 (c) Electric vehicle supply equipment installed on or after
- 11 September 1, 2023, and before March 1, 2025, must be operated in
- 12 compliance with manufacturer specifications, Chapter 2311,
- 13 Occupations Code, as added by this Act, and Texas Commission of
- 14 Licensing and Regulation rules not later than March 1, 2025.
- 15 (d) Electric vehicle supply equipment installed on or after
- 16 March 1, 2025, must be operated in compliance with manufacturer
- 17 specifications, Chapter 2311, Occupations Code, as added by this
- 18 Act, and Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation rules, and be
- 19 registered with the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation
- 20 prior to operation.
- 21 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
