Section 455.005, Occupations Code, is amended by amending Subsections (b) and (c) and adding Subsection (e) to read 6 as follows: 7 Subject to Subsection (c), this [This] chapter does not 8 (b) affect a local regulation that: 9 10 (1) relates to: 11 (A) zoning requirements, including conditional 12 use permits; (B) hours of operation; or 13 14 (C) other [similar] regulations similar to those described by Paragraph (A) or (B) for massage establishments; 15 16 (2) authorizes or requires an investigation into the background of an owner or operator of, or an investor in, a massage 17 18 establishment; or (3) does not relate directly to the practice 19 of massage therapy as performed by a licensed massage therapist, 20 including a regulation related to a license holder listed in 21 Section 455.004, while the therapist: 22 23 (A) performs under the applicable licensing law; 24 and

No. 1009 (B) works with a licensed massage therapist. 1 A [Except as provided by Chapter 243, Local Government 2 (c) 3 Code, a] political subdivision may not adopt a regulation of the type described by Subsection (b) that is more restrictive for 4 massage therapists or massage establishments than for other health 5 care professionals or establishments, except that a more 6 restrictive regulation of the type described by Subsection (b) may 7 8 be adopted: (1) as provided by Chapter 243, Local Government Code; 9 10 (2) if regulating the hours of operation of a massage therapist or massage establishment; or 11 12 (3) if the regulation relates to the ownership or operation of a massage establishment, or the provision of massage 13 14 therapy, by a person: 15 (A) who has on three or more occasions been arrested or issued a citation in lieu of arrest for an offense under 16 17 Section 43.02, 43.021, 43.03, 43.04, 43.05, or 71.02, Penal Code; (B) who has been <u>convicted of an offense under</u> 18 Chapter 20A, or Section 34.02, 43.02, 43.021, 43.03, 43.04, 43.05, 19 or 71.02, Penal Code; 20 21 (C) against whom a sanction has been imposed for a violation of this chapter; or 22 23 (D) who has owned or operated a massage 24 establishment against which a sanction has been imposed for a violation for this chapter. 25 (e) In this section, "sanction" has the meaning assigned by 26 Section 51.001. 27
