- 6 SECTION 1. Section 7.061, Education Code, is amended by

- 9 the commissioner shall incorporate the new school facility safety

- 11 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 7, Education Code, is
- 12 amended by adding Section 7.0615 to read as follows:
- Sec. 7.0615. NEW SCHOOL FACILITY SAFETY AND SECURITY RULES
- 14 AND STANDARDS. (a) The commissioner, in collaboration with the
- 15 Texas School Safety Center, shall establish a committee to develop
- 16 rules and standards for required school safety and security
- 17 features for newly constructed school district and open-enrollment
- 18 charter school facilities.
- 19 (b) Any school district or open-enrollment charter school
- 20 facility for which construction commences on or after January 1,
- 21 2024, must comply with the rules and standards developed by the

- 2 commissioner of the Texas Education Agency, in collaboration with
- 3 the Texas School Safety Center, shall establish the committee
- 4 required under Section 7.0615, Education Code, as added by this

- 6 (b) Not later than December 1, 2023, the Texas Education
- 7 Agency shall publish on its Internet website the rules and
- 8 standards developed under Section 7.0615, Education Code, as added
- 9 by this Act.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
